JOB DESCRIPTION:

CMAs are medically trained professionals assisting doctors, and other healthcare specialists in hospitals, medical offices and clinics. They can take vital signs, perform EKG's, draw blood, administer medications and update medical records.

SALARY RANGE:

\$12 - \$20 hourly

EMPLOYMENT:

Work as a CMA

- Primarily employed in outpatient medical offices, clinics, and hospitals

ADDITIONAL TRAINING:

Certified Training Program (9 - 12 months)
• Includes both classroom instruction and clinical practice time

CERTIFICATIONS/EXAMS:

Must pass a Diploma Certification Exam

PREREQUISITE:

High School (4 years) or GED
